2022/2023 REGISTRATION

Re-Registration Starts January 17, 2022

Families who already have students in our system should expect an email during the week of January 17-21, 2022 asking that the the online "Registration Update Form" be completed for each child who will be attending during the 2022/2023 school year.

This update allows us to make sure the information on file is accurate and that any legal declarations, preferences and consents are renewed. It also allows our schools to plan for the upcoming school year.

Parents/guardians who are hoping to register younger siblings new to the division will also have the opportunity to do this at the same time that they re-register older students.

New Student Registration Starts February 1, 2022

Students new to the division who wish to enroll for the 2022/2023 school year are invited to register online starting on February 1, 2022.

- Our **Early Learning Program** is designed to stimulate the growing curiosity of children 3 and 4 years of age.
- Our **Kindergarten** is designed for children 5 years of age on, or before, December 31, 2022.


DONATIONS

Schools: St. Michael's Pincher Creek

There is no one with me who contends against these princes except Michael, your prince." Daniel 10:21

"But I am to tell you what is inscribed in the book of truth.

ST. MICHAEL

This month brings us to a different kind of saint as we turn our attention to the holy archangels. St. Michael is the leader of all angels and of the army of God. This is what the title "Archangel" means, that he is above all the others in rank. St. Michael has four main responsibilities or offices, as we know from scripture and Christian tradition: 1) to fight against Satan, 2) to rescue the souls of the faithful from the Devil, especially at the hour of death, 3) to attend the dying and accompany them to judgment, and 4) to be the champion of God's people; the Israelites under the Old Law, and now the Catholic Church.

Explanation and Hierarchy of the 9 Choirs of Angels

1ST TRIAD - CONTEMPLATE AND ADORE GOD DIRECTLY

SERAPHIM (meaning "the burning ones"). They are attendants at the throne of God. They praise God singing, "Holy Holy Holy is the Lord of Hosts!" - ISAIAH 6:1-7



CHERUBIM (meaning "the fullness of wisdom"). They contemplate God's providence, and are assigned to protect special places. - EXODUS 25:18-21; EZEKIEL 10:14; REVELATIONS 4-6

THRONES represent the steadfastness of the love of God. They contemplate God's love and judgment, and they appear as the most unlike the others when revealed. - EZEKIEL 10:17; COLOSSIANS 1:16; DANIEL 7:9



2ND TRIAD - FULFILL GOD'S PLAN IN THE UNIVERSE

DOMINIONS are lord over the lower choirs and humanity. They take illumination from the higher hierarchies and govern the universe. - EPHESIANS 1:21; COLOSSIANS 1:16

VIRTUES run the operation of movement in the universe. They are often associated with planets, elements, seasons, and nature. - EPHESIANS 1:21



POWERS assist in governing the natural order. They are warrior angels tasked with fighting the war against the demonic choirs. - EPHESIANS 3:10; 6:12





3RD TRIAD - INTERACT AND SERVE HUMANITY CLOSELY

PRINCIPALITIES are of the lowest triad, assigned to care and guard communities, kingdoms, states, and parishes. They are associated with transitions in power. - EPHESIANS 1:21; 3:10

ARCHANGELS are leader angels assigned to communicate and carry out God's important plans for man Michael, Gabriel, and Rafael are the only three names we know. - JUDE 9; 1 THESSALONIANS 4:16; TOB

ANGELS are closest to the material world and humanity. The lowest choir is where we get the majority of our personal guardian angels. - MATTHEW 18:10; LUKE 22:43; HEBREWS 13:2

"For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways."
