- -Most of Linda's report is covered in the board brief
- -June 9 meeting with priests, will discuss sacramental prep
- -Met with MLAs -- CCH received \$100 000 grant but needs more
- -In general: money is tight and things will be budgeted carefully

- -Would like to see key dates two years in advance on calendar (Meghan mentioned that this can be problematic because we have to work with other school division)
- -HS School division family gathering, June 7 CCH East
- -June 13: retirement gathering at board office
- -Moochigan was awesome and so was STEAM day

### 6. Principal Report

- a) STEAM Day recap
  - -Tons of activities with trade and community partners; great experience for all students
  - -College has a STEM grant that helped us immensely -- we were the test pilot for a number of their kits
  - -Has been in planning since January
  - -Will it be a regular thing? Maybe! Meghan coordinated the whole thing this year and it was a big day, but we hope to have something similar, but it may look different
- b) Welcome back blessing date Wed. Sept. 27 (taiko?)
  - -Caryn said Hibikiya Taiko will be willing to perform for free if desired
  - -Welcome back mass in the AM
- c) Staffing for next year
  - -Mrs Nemecek has resigned her position and is going into private counseling
  - -Mrs Baptista will be staying with us permanently
  - -We will be hiring a half time position, currently posted as a 5/6 LA/math position, but our numbers are constantly changing we only have one class under 27
  - -Initial plan was to create an AM 5/6 split for LA and math, but 5/6 numbers have gone down and grade 1 numbers up, so we really have to wait and see what our numbers are
  - -Caryn and Meghan will be on grade 1 support if the grade 5/6 position is on the go
  - -We've had a number of new enrolments (5 in one day in April!) from all over the world
  - -Question regarding if we have the budget to have the new person both support 5/6 and support other groups? Each school receives a teaching allotment based on enrollment ours is 9 with Cassie being half time in kindergarten and Caryn and Meghan sharing a full time position, so we can only hire a half time person and they will not be able to support elsewhere we do not have the flexibility to adjust our budget our funding
  - -Concerns over the budget being decided so early in the year when we don't know enrolment, but it is unfortunately the consequence of the funding model from the government
  - -Question regarding physical space in the school: next year SAPDC (professional development group) will have their home base in our portables, so the 4s and 6s will move into the classrooms in the main school
  - -This has potential benefit for us by bringing teachers into our school
  - -Question about devices deferred to later report
  - -We will be losing Karin Mendoza in the office due to cuts in other areas and having Tracy Bozzi will join us in September

## e) Microsoft grant

- -In April we received a \$10 000 grant
- -Due to 3 to 1 ratio, we received 25 new iPads for div 1 but we are losing 30 Chromebooks and the old iPads (insurance prevents us from using anything older than 5 years as well)
- -We can order 14 microsoft chromebook-style devices
- -We have submitted an application for an additional grant and voting for it opens tomorrow (link is <a href="https://school-giveaway.kidoodle.tv/">https://school-giveaway.kidoodle.tv/</a>) and we will send this to the school community
- -If we receive another grant, do we want to put our STEAM funds towards filling out device carts?
- -We can't run robots or anything else without devices -- we will be pushing for BYOD wherever possible
- -We know that not all families will be able to do BYOD but we will appreciate any extras we can obtain to alleviate the stress on the school
- -We are also hoping that by building a partnership with the college and other tech organizations, we can get access to tech or programs

## 7. Teacher Report

- a) Field trips
  - -Every class has at least one, sometimes 2 field trips this month (or last)
- b) BYOD (covered previously)
- c) Grant voting (covered previously)
- -Question re busing: no email came to Selestia, but Meghan received hers on May 23 and email indicated that emails would be auto generated. Meghan will check on this
- -Michelle asked that we circle back to Full Steam Ahead -- Meghan was wondering if we receive the \$10 000, should we clump it together with the \$1350 to purchase devices?
- -Initial plan had been to fundraise heavily and fund the full \$25 000 for neuromaker, but Selestia has gotten a lot of nos -- she doesn't mind if we shift the money, but it's disappointing along with many of our fundraising efforts
- -Fundraising has been really frustrating, but Meghan reminds us that many of our families are international families on student visas. Our demographics have changed -- we have a lot of families who can't afford programs and camps, and they may not be able to participate in fundraising
- -We are also lacking in volunteers but it's good to remember everyone's situation is different -- however, there's nothing wrong with asking people to give what they can (whether that is time or money)
- -We were really excited for neuromaker but it might be too ambitious for us at the moment -more imminent need may be the devices

-Question re if we can ethically redirect that funding -- we should be able to as expressed in the fundraising letter linked here:

- -Meghan has been recruiting grade 1 parents

  - -Meghan suggested we highlight it at the next big family event, even if that's not until September
- b) Hot Lunch/ Fundraising Update Selestia
  - -hot lunch was awesome and kids loved it, responded positively to Selestia
  - -spaghetti dinner needs to be rescheduled, not canceled, because we have lots of sponsors
  - -Meghan suggested we replace the bbg night? Selestia thought the bbg is more low key
  - -- maybe closer to Thanksgiving
  - -Different options, like maybe a dessert night in September and the bigger thing in October?
  - -We will need to have an early meeting to make sure this is all ready to go in September
  - -Would like to support maybe 3 hot lunches like the hot dog day to coincide with school events
  - -We make some from hot lunches so maybe we could do more?
