Some of the roles the Resource Officer has within in the school are:

- Lock down practice administration has a direct line to the Resource officer in the event there is serious incident.
- Assist with difficult situations with children, parents, or others.
- Work together on safety decisions such as agrees it is a good idea to lock the doors to monitor who is entering and leaving the building in the event a child has a parenting order. When unlocked the doors would some times be open for more than half of the day which is too much for an unsupervised door. An intruder could enter that way without anyone knowing.
