






REMINDERS

- **School fees** are now overdue. Please login to SchoolCash Online if you have not yet paid your fees.
- **Nutrition Breaks** – we have two breaks during the day where students eat lunch and snacks. Please discuss with your child to see if they have enough for both breaks. Also, we **do not** supply spoons or forks. If you are sending something that requires utensils, please send them along.
- During the wet, snowy days, students are asked to remove their wet footwear before heading to class. Please make sure your child(ren) have indoor shoes.

COLD WEATHER

As the cold weather sets in, we want to share our procedures for recess during extreme temperatures. When the temperature drops below -20°C (including wind chill), recess will be held indoors. On some days when the temperature is below -20°C, students may be given the choice to go outside, if and only if they are properly dressed in winter gear (e.g., snow pants, mittens, hat, etc.). Students without proper clothing will be directed to stay indoors.

Please note that if the temperature is below -20, students will always have the option to remain inside. Supervision is provided both inside and outside on these days.
